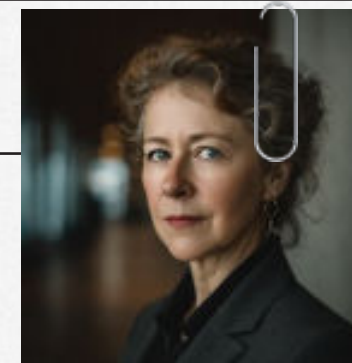


POLICE REPORT
